Football Success!

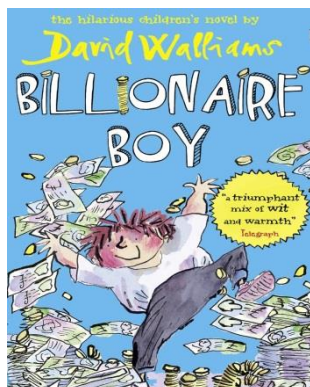
