Please do not leave the cricket club in your car until all the children are safely out of the cricket club area. Children will all walk back to school for the end of the day and be dismissed in the normal manner.

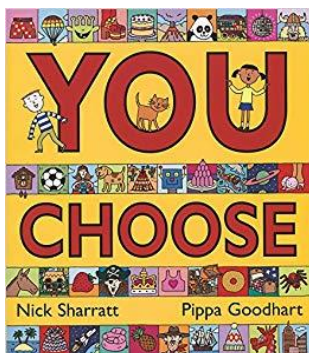
Dinners
