



## National Requirements for Swimming 2019-2020

Meeting National curriculum Requirements for swimming and water safety:	
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres? <b>N.B.</b> Even though your children may swim in another year please report on their attainment on leaving primary school.	61%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	83%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	65%
Schools can choose to use the Primary PE and Sport Premium to provide additional provision for swimming but this must be for activity <b>over and above</b> the National Curriculum requirements. Have you used it in this way?	Year Six swam at the beginning of the year as part of their National Curriculum requirement. Due to COVID19, the Year Six cohort were not able to swim for their second slot (second summer half term) which was planned with the intention of allowing children who had not yet met the requirements of the National Curriculum to achieve the expected standard. Unfortunately this did not take place. We are looking at ways of adjusting our swimming provision and investing in opportunities to support all pupils to meet the expectations by their end of KS2- please see our 'premium impact report' with suggested actions for 2020-21.
